# **i) Discussion to identify MHNA(UK) priorities for the next year** Linda Cooper/Alan Simpson The following priorities were identified in the context of the current political & economic climate by members present. Following the meeting these were discussed by the Chair and Vice Chair and the actions below suggested:

- a) Work in partnership with NHS Confederation MH network AS to invite Steve Shrubb to next meeting
- b) Provide MHNA(UK) response to imminent (due Dec 2010) DH consultation regarding commissioning of education & training and bursaries for healthcare professionals LC to invite MHNA(UK) member Dr Steven Pryjmachuk to lead consultation response
- c) Strengthen communications with Council of Deans [noted John Playe, Tony Warne, Sarah Owen & Hugh McKenna MHNA(UK) members in COD
- d) New MH Strategy for England due by end of 2010 LC to invite Ben Thomas to April 2011 meeting
- e) MHNA(UK) to undertake research. Outline proposal for bid proposed by John Baker [Manchester University]
- f) Invite new members from Universities which are currently not represented John Baker offered to provide database of all HEIs delivering MHN education or research in UK. LC to write to relevant University MH leads. Members to promote group & feed in new contacts to Chair

g) Consideration be given to inviting national MH service user & carer organisation be become affiliated to MHNA(UK) – LC to contact MH Professional Advisor for each of the 4 countries to identify national groups used by England, Wales Scotland and Northern Ireland

# ii) Information sharing – re individual HEIs approach to the development of Pre-Registration programmes to meet the 2010 NMC Standards. Linda Cooper

Sheila Dixon [Wolverhampton University] discussed a draft outline framework of interprofessional, generic & field specific modules for the new curriculum. Most present identified placement capacity being the main challenge in designing new programmes. Various solutions such hub & spoke and client allocation models were shared.

It was noted that Plymouth, Manchester & Hertfordshire were planning to implement the new programme from Sept 2011
